

Sanctity of Human Life Sunday

Sunday was the anniversary of the 1973 SCOTUS (Supreme Court of....) decision on Roe vs. Wade granting permission for abortion on demand here in America. Norma McCovey, the Plaintiff in the case, has since become a Christian and advocated for life.

Scriptural snapshots of the baby in the womb:

- *"...from a child (brephos) you have known the Holy scriptures"* 2 Timothy 3:15 Paul to Timothy speaking of the influence his mother and grandmother had on him. The Greek word for a baby in the womb (i.e. unborn infant) is used here.
- *"formed me from the womb"* Isaiah 49:1, 5

- *"The moment you walked in the room the baby leaped in my womb"* Luke 1:41, 44. Elizabeth is greeted by Mary, the mother of Jesus speaking of John, his cousin
- *"You knit me together in my mother's womb"* David in Psalm 139:13-16

God's law:

- *"You shall not kill"* Exodus 20, Deuteronomy 5
- If a pregnant woman is killed it is counted as a double homicide
- *"Yea, they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto devils, and shed innocent blood, even the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan: and the land was polluted with blood..."* Psalm 106:37 The Gods of the Canaanites were Ashterah, Baal, and Molech: sexual pleasure, financial prosperity, false religion respectively.

We know from the story of David and the child born to Bathsheba out of wedlock that children that die go to heaven: 1 Samuel 12:22-23
